



## KILIMO TRUST CALL FOR ASSOCIATES IN ARUSHA TANZANIA (04) POSITIONS

### 1. About Kilimo Trust

Kilimo Trust (KT) is an independent regional agricultural development organization - working on agriculture for development across the EAC Region. It is registered in the Republic of Uganda, and it implements projects across all EAC Partner States. The core business of KT is to support the transformation of food and nutrition security in the EAC Region away from high-risk subsistence farming into lower-risk trade-based systems.

Kilimo Trust Tanzania is implementing Accelerated Innovation Delivery Initiative Rapid Delivery Hub (AID-I) Project funded by USAID. Under this project Kilimo Trust is collaborating with World Vegetable Center, with a specific focus on market-led vegetable value chain development in Arusha, Manyara, and Kilimanjaro regions. This collaborative effort aims to strengthen market linkages for vegetable and spice farmers by providing targeted market education to enhance their understanding of market dynamics. The partnership will also involve linking farmers and other financial services and guiding farmers into various market strategies that specifically address the unique challenges and opportunities within the vegetable sector.

### 2. The Assignment:

Kilimo Trust Tanzania invites Cv's from eligible candidates/ Associates to support in Training of farmers on postharvest trainings, value addition, and strategic marketing for horticulture crops in Arusha, Manyara, and Kilimanjaro Region under the AIDI project for a period of one month.

### 3. Scope of Work:

The Associates will be required to deliver as per the below deliverables:

- a) To support mobilization and train of farmers on the postharvest, value additional and strategic marketing for horticulture crop trainings.
- b) To support demonstration on the use of innovative postharvest-reducing technologies in food crops and vegetables during the trainings
- c) To support and facilitate linkages between FBOs with suppliers of post-harvest equipment and off-takers
- d) To support in distribution of Post harvest materials and equipment's to project beneficiaries.

### 4. Duration of the Assignment:

The assignment is expected to take one (1) month from the date the contract is signed.

### 5. Qualifications:

- a) A degree in Horticulture (preferably), Agriculture, Agribusiness, or a related field.
- b) A minimum of 3 years' hands-on experience in providing business development services to farmers and identical roles is imperative.
